

## Troops Thankful for Free Call Day Program

## Over 1 million free connections made since Sept. 2010

Troops stationed overseas were able to wish their loved ones at home a happy Easter, thanks to a VFW Operation  $Uplink^{TM}$  "Free Call Day" (FCD) sponsored by the VFW Department of Texas.

Deployed military personnel took advantage of the event by visiting Internet cafes located throughout Iraq, Afghanistan and Kuwait to make over 65,000 connections home with family and friends.

The program is the only one of its kind, providing two designated days each month when deployed service members making phone calls to the U.S. and other home base locations are greeted by a recording which states the call will be **free**, courtesy of *Operation Uplink*.

With the Easter FCD, VFW surpassed 1 million free connections since September 2010.

VFW and Ladies Auxiliary members, as well as other caring citizens, generously support the program. The program provides an easy way for individuals and organizations to make an immediate difference in the lives of active-duty military personnel.
