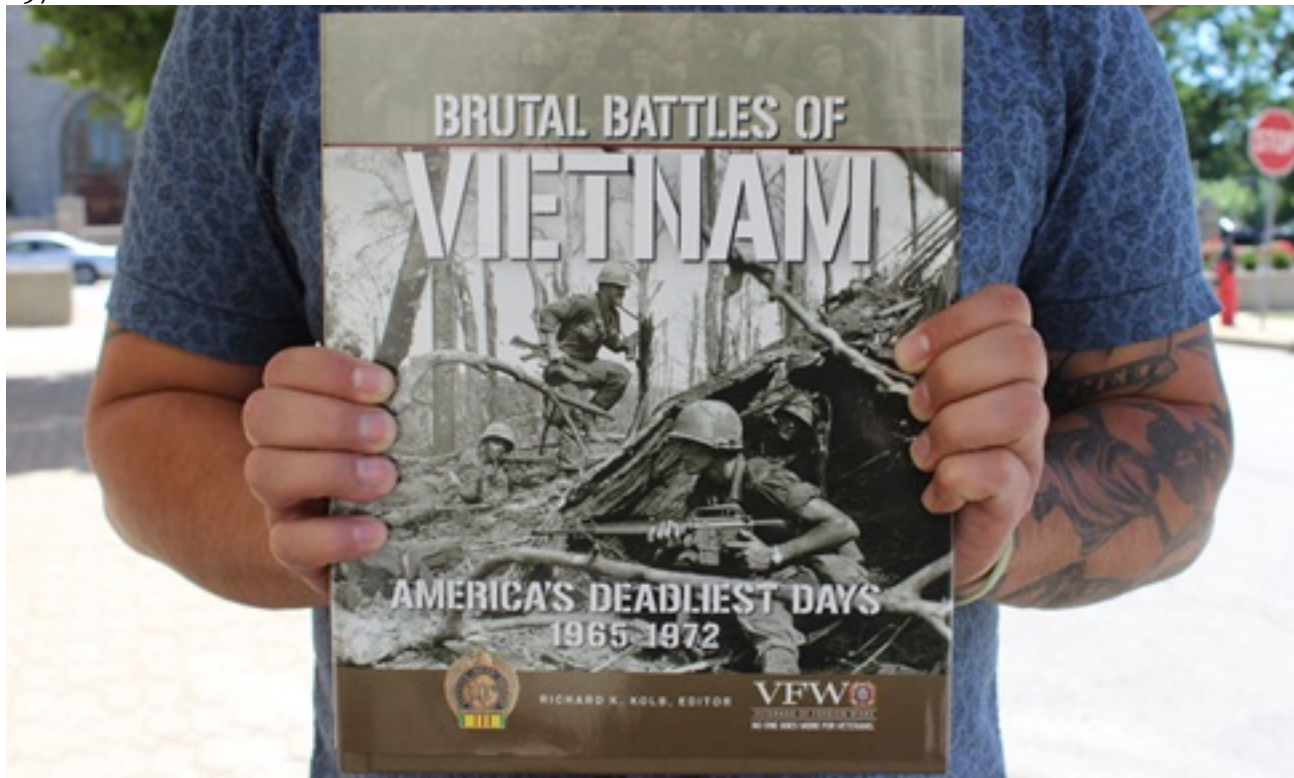


VFW Releases ‘Brutal Battles of Vietnam’ to Commemorate 50th Anniversary
